

Characteristics of Blown and Cast Film

BLOWN FILM:

- Less Expensive (although new manufacturing developments in cast processing has made the cost differential almost negligible)
 - Soft — making it easier to stretch (stretch is dependent upon the operator — our patented handle systems make stretch easier and more natural for the operator even with cast film)
 - Has good puncture resistance
 - Exerts good force-to-load holding power
-

CAST FILM:

- Superior appearance — very clear and glossy
- Stiffness — does not neck down in application, making coverage easier and more efficient
- Quiet — makes almost no noise (blown is very noisy in application)
- No telescoping — especially in rolls of 5" or less, blown film will telescope in hot weather, cast film will not telescope (telescoped film is unusable)
